Fast Facts

Youth 18 years of age and younger ride free with school ID or contact us about a pass.

The Route 1 stops in front of and across the street from the campus.

Sonoma County Transit also serves stops near the campus and can also be another transit option.

Sometimes the fastest trips do include a transfer.

Get to School On Time

"Outbound" means the part of the trip coming from the Transit Mall

"Inbound" means the part of the trip going back to the Transit Mall

Arrive at Stop #80125

Pro Tips for Planning

Figure out when you want to arrive and work backwards from that time.

If your stop is not a timepoint try to make it to your stop close to when your bus leaves the timepoint before your stop.

Always account for walking time when planning your trip.
